# TALENT DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (TDP): PURPOSE AND OVERVIEW



#### **Brief Introduction**

The Macarthur Football Association (MFA) is passionate about nurturing talent and providing a clear pathway for players of all ages and abilities. We believe everyone deserves the opportunity to develop their skills and reach their full potential in the our game.

This document outlines the newly created football pathway available in Macarthur for players aged 12-18 years old, the Talent Development Program (TDP).

# Purpose of the Talent Development Program (TDP)

The TDP aims to bridge the gap between grassroots and elite levels of football by providing a high-performance environment that will serve as additional high-quality training and games for club-based players. By selecting a group of talented players based in club football each term, it will become a program that not only supports player development in the region but also supports club development as this program will run alongside club football (rather than against it). The TDP therefore will act as both an individual player development focused program to strengthen club football, and as a talent identification process to strengthen player pathways in the region.

Through training that is delivered by experienced and qualified coaches, as well as through playing in higher-quality matches against other member associations and NPL clubs, the TDP will provide an increased number of talented players, an exposure to what a high-performance environment looks and feels like. Alongside our other player development programs, the TDP will become the crucial centrepiece in connecting grassroots and representative football together.

# Key Features of the TDP: How It Will Work



#### Rams Academy:

This program is designed for players who want to elevate their skills and potentially compete at the elite levels of JDL, NPL, or TDP. The program is a collaboration between Macarthur Football Association and Macarthur Rams FC.

#### **Association Development Program:**

A term-based community program for boys and girls aged 5-13. It's designed to supplement club training and help young players develop skills in a fun and supportive environment.



# **Head of Program: Tim Aitken**

The Talent Development Program (TDP) will be led by MFA Head of Football, Tim Aitken.

Tim brings over eight years of experience in elite football in Australia with a strong focus on player development in both the men's and women's programs.

From January 2019 to October 2024, he held dual roles at Macarthur FC—serving as the Assistant Coach for the A-League Men's First Grade team while also leading the club's NPL program as Technical Director. These positions highlight his ability to operate across professional and development environments simultaneously, delivering high standards both on and off the pitch.



Tim has also worked with Football Australia's Youth Boys State Teams at recent National Championships, helping identify and mentor emerging talent on the national stage. He was involved in the women's football environment through being assistant coach to Leah Blamey in the both the Future Matildas program and the Young Matildas Asian Cup 2024 campaign. This further showcases his ability and commitment to advancing the game for all athletes. He has been with the Macarthur Football Association since October 2024 and has shown in the short time his commitment to developing the next generation of footballers.

Holding a Football Australia A Licence, Tim brings a wealth of technical knowledge and leadership. In his role, he will oversee the delivery of a high-quality Talented Player Development (TDP) program—guiding and mentoring coaches, shaping program standards, and playing a hands-on role in the development of players within the elite pathway.



# Planned Delivery for 2025/2026

The TDP program will be run on a term-by-term basis with 18 players per age group selected by TDP coaches exclusively from the Macarthur Youth League (MYL). The following will be our planned delivery with specific age groups that will run from Term 3 2025 to Term 2 2026:

TDP coaches or MFA staff to attend MYL Games: Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> June, Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> July and Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> July. All coaches have available scouting template to identify talented opposition players.

a 10-week program run on Monday evenings @ Lynwood Park, St Helen's Park Monday 21<sup>st</sup> July – Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2025


# **Player Selection Process**

In-line with our other player development programs, the TDP will be a football player pathway opportunity made available for both boys youth and girls youth players in the Macarthur region.

The players for all age-group opportunities will be selected exclusively from the Boys and Girls Macarthur Youth League (MYL) competitions and will initially involve 18 players to be offered a spot per relevant age-group, with 6 extras players to be a standby selection. For future terms, the same selection process will take place however, a minimum of 6 new players must be selected.

#### **INITIAL PLAYER SELECTION**

18 players selected and offered spot in Talent Development Program each term (selected from Macarthur Youth League competitions)



#### 6 players picked as standby selection

(to be offered spot if any selected players decline offer; if not included, offered spot in Rams Academy w/ price discount)



#### FUTURE TERM PLAYER SELECTION (\*excluding Term 3 2026 selection)

18 players selected and offered spot in Talent Development Program

(selected from Macarthur Youth League)



(6 players removed offered spot in Rams Academy for next term (price discount); chance to rejoin TDP in future term)



#### Macarthur Team of the Year: Term 3 2026

After the completion of the Term 3 2025 to Term 2 2026 cycle, TDP coaches and supporting technical staff will select a "Macarthur Team of the Year". The Team of the Year for each relevant age-group will take part in a further term of training (Term 3 2026) and compete in an end-of-season tournament against other Member Associations and NPL clubs.

18 players selected as "Macarthur Team of the Year" - for each relevant age-group (selected from Macarthur Youth League competitions/ previous term TDP groups)





#### "Team of the Year" take part in Term 3 2026 Talent Development Program

a 10-week program run on Monday evenings @ Lynwood Park, St Helen's Park

Monday 20<sup>th</sup> July – Monday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2026

#### Compete as "Macarthur Team of the Year" at End-of-Season Tournament

End-of-Season Tournament against other Member Associations and/or NPL clubs
To take place in September/ October school holidays 2026 (full details TBC)

# **Future Delivery of Program**

In the future phases of delivery of the TDP beyond Term 3 2026, the program will take place on a yearly cycle between Term 4 and Term 3 with the below as the planned delivery for each term (e.g., for next cycle between Term 4 2026 - Term 3 2027):

Term 4 2026 = Initial TDP for 2026/27 cycle; selected from Sep 2026 school holiday trials

Term 1 2027 = TDP #2; selected from Jan 2027 school holiday trials

Term 2 2027 = TDP #3; selected on MYL Gala-Day

Term 3 2027 = TDP #4 w/ Macarthur Team of the Year + End-of-Season Tournament
